## November & December Workshops

***“Advanced Trauma-Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (TF-CBT)”***

**Wednesday, November 3 & Thursday, November 4, 2010 12 CEU Clock Hours**

This two-day advanced training session will equip participants to effectively integrate TF-CBT with children into their clinical practice. Training includes hands-on exercises on the utilization of assessment measures and documentation to streamline paperwork. You will learn how to integrate other evidence-based treatments into TF-CBT while maintaining model fidelity. Clinicians will have the opportunity to observe demonstrations and participate in small group roleplays to practice implementing the various components of the TF-CBT model. Adaptations for use with adults will be discussed. Individuals should have attended the introductory *“Trauma-Focused CBT”* workshop or completed the online TF-CBT course to effectively participate in this advanced training.

**Presenter: Cassie Hornbeck, PhD**

Cassie has a Doctor of Psychology in Clinical Psychology, an APA approved program from Wheaton College in Illinois. She provides outpatient and family psychotherapy for children, adolescents and their families at Community Services of Stark County and facilitates weekly therapy sessions at Gentle Shepherd Counseling Center.

***“Developing Confidence in Court” - A Workshop for Mental Health Practitioners***

**Wednesday, December 8, 2010 3 CEU Clock Hours**

This workshop addresses the common problems and difficulties encountered by mental health providers in the courtroom. Practical suggestions and principles for strengthening one's testimony at court will be presented. The legal and ethical ramifications on confidentiality will be considered. Topics to be addressed include “The Role of the Mental Health Providers in the Legal System”, “Dealing with Lawyers and the Courts”, “Confidentiality & Law,” “Giving Testimony through Deposition on the Stand”, “If, When & How to Defend One's Credentials, Opinions & Integrity” and “Power, Control & Comfortable Competence on the Witness Stand”.
